New Member Fee: \$310 (one-time **administration** fee assessed by National Office within 10 days of bid acceptance) Annual Programming and Benefits Fee: \$530 (annual **property, casualty, and liability insurance fee** assessed by National Office each year) Greekbill Fee from National: \$18 per semester - \$36 per year **member software usage fee** assessed by National Office New Member Fee to local Chapter: \$50 per month **facilities/food usage fee** (until the end of the school year)

LIVE-IN MEMBER FEES

Annual Programming and Benefits Fee: \$530 (annual **property, casualty, and liability insurance & administration** fee assessed by National Office each year)

Room & Board: Choose one of two payment plans Option #1: Double Occupancy - Pay \$5,500 a semester (about a 16% discount over the monthly rate) or Pay \$1,600 per month (approx. equal to average Purdue Dorm rate) Option #2: Triple Occupancy - Pay \$5,000 per semester (about a 18% discount over the monthly rate) or Pay \$1,475 per month.

Technology Fee: \$250 per semester – provides wireless internet service throughout the premises, including technology infrastructure and equipment.

Laundry Fee: \$75 per semester – enables members to use four fee-free washers and dryers

Security Deposit: \$1,000 (one-time fee, refundable upon graduation **from the university** if housing contract **and out-of-house contract** requirements met)

NOTE

All members are expected to live in the chapter house **per the agreed upon housing contract** while attending Purdue University.
